This one day workshop has been arranged by Food and Farming Compliance Ltd., to provide an update and refresher training on the requirement of the laws to protect poultry during transport

This workshop will explore and explain the roles and responsibilities of those concerned with transport of poultry. It will outline the principals of transporting birds by road on short journeys (under 8 hours) and provide 7hrs Driver cpc Periodic Training

Those who wish to take this assessment must forward their Name, Address and Date and place of Birth to the Course Organiser at least 3 days before the date of the course for registration purposes.
